SILLY SENTANCE BUILDER

This simple activity encourages early literacy & imagination.

What you need: just words and laughter

1. Take turns starting a sentence:
"The cow went to the..."
2. Let your child finish with something funny
3. Keep going to create a silly mini story together

This fun activity builds sentence structure, vocabulary, rhyming and humour. At Miss Parkers Preschool we believe the foundation of writing begins with spoken language and a rich bank of vocabulary.

EARLY LITERACY SPOTLIGHT

WHY WE SING, RHYME & TALK MORE

These joyful interactions are not just fun, they are doing powerful work:

Rhyming and singing help children hear patterns in language, which is essential for learning sounds (phonological awareness)

Conversation-rich play builds vocabulary, comprehension and confidence, the foundation of future reading

Silly sentence play and sound games help children tune into beginning sounds, preparing them for phonics

Storytelling and repetition strengthen children's memory and sequencing, which leads directly to writing and storytelling later on.
